

Comparison of Crime in Maharashtra as against Crime In India for the year 2014

(Based on Crime In India, - 2014 published by N.C.R.B., New Delhi)

1. Crime Trend of Cases Registered Under I.P.C.

- In India, Total 2851563 cases have been registered under the crime heads of IPC. Out of which Maharashtra State reported 249834 (8.8%) and Madhya Pradesh reported 272423 (9.6%). The crime rate in India, is 229.2 and it is 212.3 in Maharashtra State. Maharashtra State stands 17th in India in regard to crime rate.
- Among all mega cities in India, Total 616639 cases have been registered under crime heads of IPC. The highest number of cases have been reported in Delhi City 139707 (22.7%) followed by Mumbai 40361 (6.6%), Bengaluru 31852 (5.2%), Kolkata 26161 (4.2%) and Jaipur 26070 (4.2%). Mumbai stands 42th in regard to crime rate.

Murder

- In India, Out of total cases registered under this crime head, Uttar Pradesh has reported (5150) highest number of cases followed by Bihar (2402), Maharashtra (2670), Madhya Pradesh (2274), West Bengal (2217). Maharashtra stands 19th in India in regard to crime rate under this crime head.
- In India, among mega cities, the highest number of cases have been reported in Delhi City (472), Bengaluru (241), Patna (205), Mumbai (183) and Chennai(161). Mumbai stands 26th in regard to crime rate under this crime head.

Attempt to commit Murder

- In India, out of total cases registered under this crime head, highest number of cases have been reported in West Bengal (7248) followed by Uttar Pradesh (5223), Bihar (4379), Tamil Nadu (2922) and Maharashtra (2613). Maharashtra stands 16th in India in regard to crime rate under this crime head.
- In India, among mega cities, the highest number of crime reported is Delhi (675), Bengaluru (489), Chennai (225), Indore(183) and Mumbai (181). Mumbai stands 31st in India in regard to crime rate under this crime head.

Kidnapping and Abduction

- In India, Out of total cases registered under this crime head, highest number of cases have been reported in Madhya Pradesh (7833), Delhi (7173), Bihar (6570), West Bengal (6110) and Rajasthan (5671).Maharashtra reported 3793 cases under this crime head. Maharashtra stands 19th in India in regard to crime rate under this crime head.
- In India, among mega cities, under this crime head, Delhi City has reported (6016) highest number of cases followed by Bengaluru (708), Jaipur(653), Patna (599), Indore (439) and Mumbai (541). Mumbai stands 36th in India in regard to crime rate under this crime head.

Dacoity

- Under this crime head, Maharashtra has reported (885) highest number of cases followed by Bihar (538), Odisha (484), Gujarat (296) and Uttar Pradesh (294). Maharashtra stands 4th in India in regard to crime rate under this crime head.
- In India, among mega cities, under this crime head, Pune (92) recorded highest number of cases followed by Delhi (65), Bengaluru (51), Mumbai (34) and Patna (28). Mumbai stands 10th in India in regard to crime rate under this crime head.

Robbery

- In India, out of total cases registered under this crime head, highest number of cases are reported in Maharashtra (9466) followed by Delhi (6464), Uttar Pradesh (3920), Karnataka (2516) and Madhya Pradesh (1969). In regard to crime rate under this crime head, Maharashtra stands at 1st.
- In India, among mega cities, under this crime head, highest number of cases are reported in Delhi (5847) followed by Mumbai (2094), Bengaluru (1067), Pune (873) and Nagpur (505). In regard to crime rate under this crime head, Mumbai stands 2nd in India.

Theft

- In India, Out of total cases registered under this crime head, highest number of cases have been reported in Delhi (78753) followed by Maharashtra (56283), Uttar Pradesh (48380), Madhya Pradesh (29244) and Rajasthan (29095). In regard to crime rate under this crime head, Maharashtra stands 2nd in India.
- In India, among mega cities, under this crime head, Delhi City has reported (8939) highest number of cases followed by Bengaluru (11455), Mumbai (10101). Mumbai stands 3rd in regard to crime rate under this crime head in India.

Burglary

- In India, Out of total cases registered under this crime head, highest number of cases have been reported in Maharashtra (17171) followed by Madhya Pradesh (12110), Delhi (10309), Uttar Pradesh (6717) and Haryana (6717). In regard to crime rate under this crime head, Maharashtra stands 1st in India.
- In India, among mega cities, under this crime head, Delhi City (8939) has reported highest number of cases followed by Mumbai (3055), Bengaluru (1542), Indore (1388) and Pune (1362). Mumbai stands 2nd in regard to crime rate under this crime head in India.

Riots

- In India, Out of total cases registered under this head, Bihar has reported (13566) highest number of cases followed by Maharashtra (7760), Karnataka (6520), Uttar Pradesh (6438) and Kerala (5820). In regard to crime rate under this crime head, Maharashtra stands 2nd in India.
- In India, among mega cities, under this crime head, Patna (470) recorded highest number of cases followed by Mumbai (409), Bengaluru (388), Kolkata (315) and Kollam (301). In regard to crime rate under this crime head, Mumbai stands 2nd in India.

Criminal Breach of Trust

- In India, Out of total cases registered under this crime head, Uttar Pradesh (4074) has reported highest number of cases followed by Maharashtra (1958), Assam (1952), West Bengal (1921), Bihar (1219). In regard to crime rate under this crime head, Maharashtra stands 2nd in India.
- In India, among mega cities, under this crime head, Mumbai (672) reported highest number of cases followed by Delhi (593), Lukhnow (459), Kolkata (338) and Jaipur (320). In regard to crime rate under this crime head, Mumbai stands 1st in India.

Cheating

- In India, Out of total cases registered under this crime head, Rajasthan (21191) reported highest number of cases followed by Uttar Pradesh (10636), Maharashtra (9959), Telangana (8519) and Karnataka (6935). In regard to crime rate under this crime head, Maharashtra stands 3rd in India.
- In India, among mega cities, under this crime head, Jaipur (4634) reported highest number of cases followed by Delhi City (4119), Bengaluru (3045), Mumbai (2594) and Hyderabad (2557). In regard to crime rate under this crime head, Mumbai stands 3rd in India.

Hurt

- In India, out of total cases registered under this crime head, West Bengal (17351) has reported highest number of cases followed by Bihar (17351), Madhya Pradesh (12113), Uttar Pradesh (10867) and Maharashtra (8126). Maharashtra stands 5th in India in regard to crime rate under this crime head.
- In India, among mega cities, cases registered under this head, Patna (2515) has reported highest number of cases followed by Mumbai (2006), Kolkata (905), Delhi City (606) and Pune (470). Mumbai stands 2nd in India in regard to crime rate under this crime head.

2. Crime against Women

- In India, Total 337922 cases reported under this crime head, in which Uttar Pradesh (38467) (11.4%) reported highest number of cases followed by West Bengal (38299) (11.3%), Rajasthan 31151 (9.2%), Madhya Pradesh 28678 (8.5%) and Maharashtra 26693 (7.9%). Maharashtra stands 18th in India in regard to crime rate under this crime head.

A. Rape

- In India, Out of total cases registered under this crime head, Madhya Pradesh 5076 (13.8%) reported highest number of cases followed by Rajasthan 3759 (10.2%), Uttar Pradesh 3467 (9.4%), Maharashtra 3438 (9.4%), and Delhi 2096 (5.7%). Maharashtra stands 20rd in India in regard to crime rate under this crime head.

B. Kidnapping and Abduction

- In India, Out of cases reported under this crime head, Uttar Pradesh 10626 (18.5%) reported highest number of cases followed by Madhya Pradesh 5688 (9.9%), West Bengal 4976 (8.7%), Bihar 4735 (8.3%) and Rajasthan 4421 (7.7%). Maharashtra reported 2457 (4.3%) cases under this crime head. Maharashtra stands 23rd in India in regard to crime rate under this crime head.

C. Dowry Deaths

- In India, Out of total cases registered under this crime head, Uttar Pradesh 2469 (29.2%) reported highest number of cases followed by Bihar 1773 (16.2%). Maharashtra reported 279 (3.3%) cases under this crime head. Maharashtra stands 15th in India in regard to crime rate under this crime head.

D. Molestation (Assault on Women with intent to outrage her modesty)

- In India, Out of cases reported under this crime head, Maharashtra 10001(12.2%) reported highest number of cases followed by Madhya Pradesh 9609 (11.7%), Uttar Pradesh 8605 (10.5%), Rajasthan 5999 (7.3%) and West Bengal 5670 (6.9%). Maharashtra stands 12th in regard to crime rate under this crime head.

E. Sexual Harassment (Insult to the modesty of Women)

- In India, Out of total cases registered under this crime head, Andhra Pradesh 2649 (27.2%) reported highest number of cases followed by Maharashtra 1575 (16.2%). Maharashtra stands 9th in regard to crime rate under this crime head.

F. Cruelty by Husband or Relatives

- In India, Out of cases reported under this head, West Bengal 23278 (18.9%) reported highest number of cases followed by Rajasthan 15905 (12.9%), Uttar Pradesh 10471 (8.5%), Assam 9626(7.8%), and Maharashtra 7696 (6.3%). Maharashtra stands 14th in regard to crime rate under this crime head.

G. Immoral Traffic (P) Act

- In India, Out of cases reported under this head, Tamil Nadu 471 (22.8%) reported highest number of cases followed by Andhra Pradesh 204 (9.9 %) and Maharashtra 202 (9.8%). Maharashtra stands 8th in regard to crime rate under this crime head.

3. Crime against Schedule Caste Persons

- In India, Out of total 47064 cases registered under this crime head, Uttar Pradesh 8075 (17.2%) reported highest number of cases followed by Rajasthan 8028 (17.1%), Bihar 7893 (16.8%), Madhya Pradesh 4151 (8.8%), Andhra Pradesh 4114 (8.7%), and Maharashtra 1768 (3.8%). Maharashtra stands 16th in India in regard to crime rate (23.4) under this crime head.

4. Crime against Children

- In India, Out of total 89423 cases registered under this crime head, Madhya Pradesh 15085 (16.9%) reported highest number of cases followed by Uttar Pradesh 14835 (16.6%), Delhi 9350 (10.5%), Maharashtra 8114 (9.1%) and West Bengal 4909 (5.5%). Maharashtra stands 14th in India in regard to crime rate (16.7) under this crime head.
