

## COMPETITION IN ANTI SABOTAGE CHECK AT THE

### 11<sup>th</sup> MAHARASHTRA STATE POLICE DUTY MEET – 2013

1. This competition is open to all Police officers who are engaged in duties relating to Anti-Sabotage check or have adequate knowledge in the field.
2. Each Range/Commissionerate may send a team of three representatives to take part in this competition.  
A competitor taking part in this competition will not be allowed to Participate in this competition in the subsequent three years. The Range IGs / Commissioners of Police or any other officer of the respective participating Range / Commissionerate authorized by him will have to certify in writing that this condition of eligibility has been correctly observed.
4. Details regarding the subject for the competition would be explained by the judges to the competitors before the commencement of the competition.
5. The competitors would be required to bring their own equipment which should be in perfect order. In case of faulty equipment, no substitute equipment will be provided. The following equipment are regarded as essential:
  - a) Explosive detector
  - b) Mine Sweeper
  - c) Hand held metal detector
  - d) Search Mirror
  - e) Search Light
  - f) Desirable Equipment – Non-linear junction detector
6. The concealed devices would contain the following items:  
Real explosives  
Dummy Detonators  
Power source  
Switch.
7. Areas of search (may be more than one) would include room/ open lawn/ vehicle.
8. Each team would be allotted 20 minutes for conducting the anti-sabotage check.
9. Maximum marks would be 100 and their distribution would be as given below:
  - a) Procedure adopted for carrying out Anti-Sabotage checks. - 30
  - b) Number of devices detected - 30
  - c) Identification of explosive - 20
  - d) Viva Voce - 20
10. The competitors will be judged by a panel of judges whose decision in all matters would be final.
